Industry Choices (Select up to 10):

The reason is that you may end up sending your resume to recruiters with very narrowly defined industry niches. These recruiters only want resumes from candidates in their small industry niche.

Instead choose Generalist in the industry category and then perhaps 6 or so other industry categories that seem to make sense for your experience.

The database system allows you to select from a list of 100+ industries. In selecting from the industry list, choose the industries where you have the most experience. Recruiters are looking for matches to their current assignments and will contact you only if you have the right industry or position experience.

Venture Cap/PE professionals are looking for management for client/portfolio companies. They will contact you only if you are a senior level executive in their client/portfolio firms' industry.

Geographic targeting choices

The database system allows you to restrict your selection by location. But do remember that a recruiter in Los Angeles or New York or Dallas or Atlanta could be working on an assignment in your area. The recruiter will contact you if you are a match for the assignment, regardless of your location. If you are location-restricted, state that in your cover letter. But even if you cannot move, becoming known to recruiters who work in your field is a good job-hunting strategy. For most searches, we recommend that we do NOT narrow by location, meaning that we would search for firms nationwide, in either the U.S. or Canada or both, as appropriate.

A venture cap/private equity professional in Los Angeles or New York or Dallas or Atlanta could be working with a company in your area. If you are location-restricted, state that in your cover letter. Even if you cannot move, becoming known to venture cap/PE professionals who work in your industry is a good job-hunting strategy.

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Frequently Asked Questions:

FAQ: What kind of firms do you include in your recruiter database?

The recruiter database consists primarily of executive search firms and personnel agencies. In addition, we include companies, not strictly executive search firms or personnel agencies, that seek executives for direct or contract hire. These companies include

- turnaround/restructuring management consulting firms, which could be hiring interim employees/managers for their clients and are coded under consulting for both industry and position specialties
- accounting firms, coded under accounting for both industry and position specialties
- IT consulting firms, coded under IT for positions

FAQ: What kind of firms do you include in your venture cap/PE database?

The venture cap/PE database consists primarily of traditional venture capital and private equity firms. In addition, we include firms that supply capital to companies or that provide advice to these companies such as

- investment or merchant banks
- subsidiaries or affiliates of banks
- subsidiaries or affiliates of operating companies, and
- subsidiaries or affiliates of financial services companies, government funds, R&D funds, and consultants.

Our venture cap/PE database is designed for senior level executives to reach venture-backed companies who need management. Job hunters can select these firms by the industries in which they invest.

FAQ: I can work in any industry – how should I use your database?

Even if you think you can work in any industry, you should not choose all the industry categories or leave the industry choice blank. The reason is that you may end up sending your resume to recruiters with very narrowly defined industry niches. These recruiters only want resumes from candidates in their small industry niche.

Instead choose Generalist in the industry category and then perhaps 6 or so other industry categories that seem to make sense for your experience. Then download the first plus matching for the csv file.

FAQ: What does the category 'generalist' mean?

The 'generalist' category is used for recruiters who tell us they will work in any industry. It is a catch-all category and should be used most often when there are only a small number of firms/recruiters in the database that match your specialties.

FAQ: What does "Add Major Generalist" mean?

This option allow a user to add large retainer-only generalist firms (like Heidrick & Struggles, Egon Zehnder, or Korn Ferry) who may not state they specialize in a specific industry/position, but are large enough to have assignments in that industry/position anyway. These firms tend to work with more senior level assignments and are recommended for job-seekers in the \$100k+ salary range.

FAQ: How do I search for international positions?

We include only US and Canadian based recruiters in our database, since the demand for recruiters based outside North America is small.

But most senior executives who want to search internationally do well with the Major recruiters in our database. There are hundreds of recruiters in the database who work with international positions in the

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\$100k+ space. Job-hunters who want to work abroad should contact them by choosing 'international' from the industry and position lists.

In addition our Venture Capital/Private Equity database contains many firms who invest internationally and may be looking for senior executives to manage their international portfolio companies.

FAQ: How accurate and up-to-date is this information?

Our databases are meticulously researched collections of information about the firms we follow. We update our databases continuously as new data become available from our telephone research or from bounces sent to us by users. We update our online system at least once each week.

In general, we collect information on each company in our data file by telephone, aiming to call each of the companies at least once every 18 months or so.

Even though companies are scheduled for telephone calls every 18 months, the ability to get bounces from email campaigns helps us target records that may have changed. As we get bounces from our customers' email campaigns, these records are checked and updated immediately from web sites and public sources or taken out of the file if necessary.
